As a member, YOU reflect the Palmetto Tatters Guild, wherever you may be; in the general public, in Palmetto Tatters Guild meetings, at TAT Day and at other lace events. Let your comments and actions reflect positively upon the Guild. Please forward questions to the Executive Board and/or refer to the Palmetto Tatters Guild By-Laws.

1. We respect, at all times, the lace and belongings of others. At Palmetto Tatters Guild we have a white glove attitude. Touching or critiquing others lace is only done with permission. It is polite to say “May I see what you have done?” or “May I suggest. . .”
2. We have limited time allotted for business meetings, so we can focus on tatting. We wait to be recognized by the President, not interrupting during meetings.
3. If you would like to add an item to the business meeting agenda, please send your request, along with any background information, to the Guild’s President at least two (2) weeks prior to the meeting.
4. During organized teaching time, we defer to the assigned instructor and instruct only when asked to do so.
