

Hat Pin Cushion Homework

Techniques: Split ring
Bridging
Long, stacked, measured picots

Materials: 20/40 thread or equivalent
Long picot gauge 7mm; 1/4" (toffee apple stick)
2 shuttles



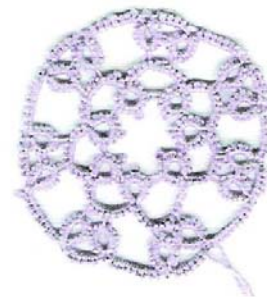
Wind 2 shuttles with continuous thread.

1st round R 4 – 3 – 3 – 4.
Ch 4 – 4 – 4.
*R 4 + 3 – 3 – 4 (join to 3rd picot of previous ring)
Ch 4 – 4 – 4 * repeat from * to * 4 times
R 4 + 3 – 3 + 4 (join to 3rd picot of previous ring & 1 picot of first ring)
Ch 4 – 4 – 4 (join to top of 1st ring. Bridge the last 4 chain)

2nd round SR 7 / 3 – 4 (or 7 + 7 if starting as new round)
Ch 9
*R 7 + 3 – 4 (join to picot of next chain of previous round)
Ch 6
R 4 + 3 + 7 (join to P of previous ring and next P on previous round)
Ch 9 *
Repeat from * to * 5 times
R 7 + 3 – 4. (join to P of previous round and 1st P of first ring)
Ch 6 + (join to top of SR)

Cut card template of motif at the end of this round for base of pincushion.

3rd round SR 7 / 7
Ch 9
R 7 + 7 (to top of next ring of previous row)
Ch 6
R 7 + 7 (to top of ring of previous row)
Ch 9
Repeat around the with last chain joining to the top of SR.



4th round As third round

5th round SR 7 / 7
Ch 3 – 3 – 3
R 7 + 7 (top top of ring of previous row)
Ch 6
Repeat joining the last Ch to top of SR

Cut, tie and finish.
