

Celtic Hat Class Homework

Thank you for choosing my class. I hope we all have a lot of fun. We will be working in the Celtic style with separate pieces woven together and then locked in place by the following rounds.

So that we may get further along during class, please work the first piece ahead of time. This section consists of 2 rounds of 8 rings/split rings each, joined to make a circle.

Abbreviations:

R	Ring
SR	Split ring
P, -	Picot
vsp	Very small picot
CTM	Continuous thread method
+	Join
/	Division for second part of split ring

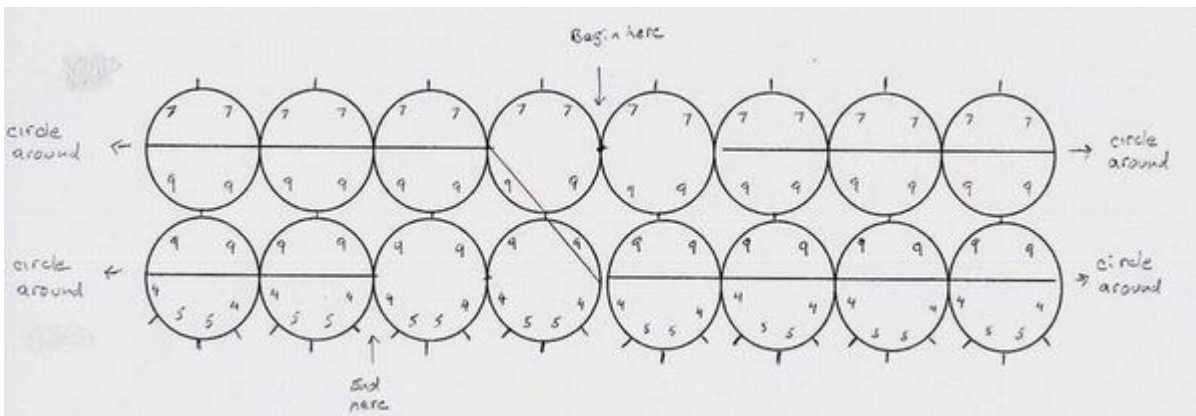
Section 1: This section forms the groundwork for the crown of the hat. Note: in this section, leave no spaces or mock picots between rings and split rings

Rnd 1: 2 shuttles wound CTM with Color A.

R: 9 vsp 9 vsp 7 - 7.
 (SR: 7 - 7 / 9 vsp 9.)x6
 SR: 7 - 7 + (to vsp of 1st R) 9 / 9.

Rnd 2: SR: 9 / 9 vsp 4 - 5 - 5 - 4.

(SR: 9 + (to vsp of Rnd 1) 9 / 4 - 5 - 5 - 4.)x6
 R: 9 + (to vsp of Rnd 1) 9 + (to vsp of 1st SR of Rnd 2) 4 - 5 - 5 - 4. Cut and tie.



Extra Credit Assignment:

The next piece(s) will work through the openings of Section 1. Can you design your own? You may tat it or make a sketch. Each ring/split ring of Section 1 needs an element that extends through it with a picot in the center. We'll share these ideas during class, and you may then complete your hat with the pattern as provided, or incorporate one of these extra credit variations.
