

Tat Days 2013 "Tatting Takes Wing" Tat Off! Patterns

General Instructions


Leave 2 to 3 inches between motifs. No need to tie or cut.

Abbreviations

-	Small-length picot	R	Ring
--	Medium length picot	.	Close
---	Long/large picot	X	Times
Ch	Chain	DS	Double stitch(es)
SLT	Shoe Lace Trick (to flip threads)	RW	Reverse work
SSh	Switch shuttles	DNRW	Do not reverse work


Speed Tat Off! Pattern - How FAST are you?

<p>R 2 --- 8 -- 2 -- 10 .</p> <p>Make second ring VERY CLOSE to first ring.</p> <p>R 3 - 6 .</p>

Blindfolded Tat Off! Pattern - How GOOD are you?

	R: 2 --- 1 --- 1 --- 1 --- 1 --- 2 .
	Repeat 2X more.

Two-Person Tat-Off! Pattern

How LONG can you and your partner make a bracelet in 10 minutes?

"Friendship Bracelet" by Donna Thompson

Thread size 3 or 5 works up really fast for a full length bracelet.

(Any size is fine for the Tat Off!)

Two shuttles, two colors.

Leave a 2-inch tail.

Tie threads together.

SLT pulls the rings together.

**Josephine Ch: 5 1st-half stitches, 5 2nd-half stitches; repeat 5X. RW.

R: 9 DS . RW SSh

R: 9 DS .

R: 9 DS . DNRW SLT

Ch: 20 DS . RW

R: 9 DS . RW SSh

R: 9 DS .

R: 9 DS . DNRW SLT

Ch: 20 DS . RW

R: 9 DS . RW SSh

R: 9 DS .

R: 9 DS . DNRW SLT

Repeat from ** until bracelet is desired length.

Tie on clasps and share.
