Tat Off! Pattern 2016 "Flames"



Shuttle/Needle and Ball Any size thread. Any color.

One long chain.
-picots can be any size
The pattern calls for 10 first ½ stitches (seta) and 10 second ½ stitches (setb).
This gives you the curling effect.

Leave about 2 inches on both threads before first stitch.

First $\frac{1}{2}$ double-stitch flipped Second $\frac{1}{2}$ double stitch unfllipped to lock core thread.

*10 seta 10 setb -1 ds * repeat *

After 4 to 6 inches, leave 2 to 4 inches bare thread. Begin again.
