

Button Flower Oya Igne Style



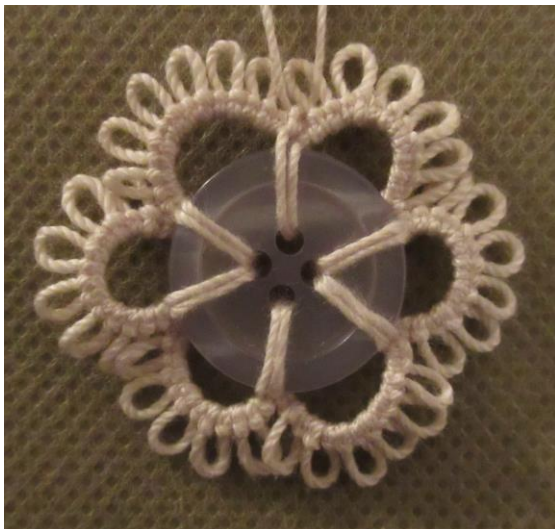

Materials:

Shuttle and Ball if using one color of thread or 2 Shuttles with one color of thread each.
Thread #10 one or two colors
One 4-holes button 1 inch
Fine crochet hook if shuttle doesn't have one
Scissors
Tapestry needle to hide ends

Homework Instructions/Preparation:

*Note: The amount of picots depends on the size of your button. Have in mind that the amount should **always** be a pair number (4, 6 8, etc).*



Join to any hole on the button and made a chain of 6 picots separated by 2 double stitches. Join to the next hole with a lock stitch. Repeat chain around the button joining twice to next hole, once to next hole and twice to last hole. In total you will have 6 petals. Join to the base of the first petal and tie.

If you're working in one color you can cut the ball thread, leaving a tail of 4-6 inches to hide the ends when finished.

If you are using 2 colors, you will do the next round using the working shuttle.
