OPEN ENTRY REGISTRATION PERIOD **July 1 - September 1, 2021**

**Register your pieces online.** There is no fee to register during July and August. **Late Entry Registration: Sept. 2 – Sept. 18, 2021 (\$25 late fee imposed).**

**NEW IN 2021: Entry tags will not be mailed. Entry tags will be available at time of delivery of exhibit(s) to the fair.**

**PLEASE NOTE: Exhibits must be delivered in person. Mailed or shipped exhibits will not be accepted.**

Palmetto Tatter will gladly deliver your handiwork if you get them your pieces **before Oct 4<sup>th</sup>.**

**Date of Judging** (Closed to public): **Thursday, October 7, 2021**

**Pickup: Monday, October 25<sup>th</sup> and Tues. October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 8AM - 6PM**

(At your request, a Palmetto Tatter can pickup your pieces, provided they have the pickup tags, and will return your pieces at the November meeting unless you need them before then.)

### Exhibitor

- Must be a resident of South Carolina
- May enter one (1) article per class (numbered category)
- No article having previously been shown at the Fair and having received a premium may be entered.
- All work must have been done by the exhibitor and within the last three (3) years.
- All classes should be entered only by **amateurs. A Professional Exhibitor is defined as anyone who has earned more than \$1,000 during a calendar year either by selling their items, teaching the subject, doing extended exhibiting, or involving themselves in other professionally related activities in a capacity that would give the entrant unfair advantage over a hobbyist.**

**YOUTH** have 2 categories: Age 11 AND UNDER and Ages 12-18

- Creativity (pattern changes, color changes, originality)
- Overall beauty
- Technique (difficulty of pattern, fabric count)
- Uniformity of stitches
- Finishing and construction finishes
